

# AWARDS

## 1. EDUSAVE & EAGLES AWARDS

- Edusave awards are given by the government annually to **Singaporean** pupils to help equalise educational opportunities and to motivate pupils to excel in schools.
- EAGLES awards for Achievement, Good Leadership & Service (EAGLES) is given out to reward pupils who have demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities, service to community and schools and excellence in non-academic activities.

Eligibility criteria and quantum for the various awards are as follows:

2. Pupils who have been awarded an Edusave Scholarship, Merit Bursary, or Good Progress Award are also eligible for EAGLES Awards.
3. Gross household income is based on monthly income of parents and siblings in the same household.
4. Pupils with Beta records are not eligible for the above Awards.
