AWARDS

1. EDUSAVE & EAGLES AWARDS

- Edusave awards are given by the government annually to Singaporean pupils to help equalise educational opportunities and to motivate pupils to excel in schools.
- EAGLES awards for Achievement, Good Leadership & Service (EAGLES) is given out to reward pupils who have demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities, service to community and schools and excellence in non-academic activities.

Eligibility criteria and quantum for the various awards are as follows:
